CHOOSE ONE TASK

- » Imagine that an extraordinary event has occurred on one of the Red Funnel Ferries or Red Jets. Write a TV news report (or a newspaper report), detailing the story.
- » Imagine that the Red Funnel ship suddenly stops in the middle of the Solent. Out of the water emerges a huge creature that has never been seen before. Design your beast before writing a description of its features.
- » Examine a range of shape poems. Can you write your own example, in the shape of a Red Funnel vessel?
- » On your next journey, you would really like to go on to the bridge, to see how the captain navigates the ship. Write a persuasive letter to the captain, outlining why you should be chosen to go into the captain's quarters.
- » Imagine that the ferry sails you in to an imaginary land. Write a story opener, detailing the scene which you first encounter.
