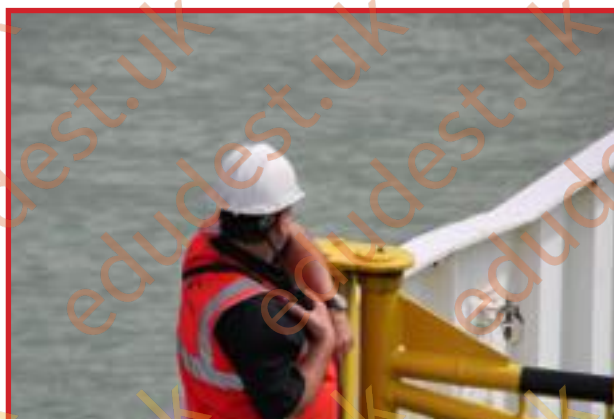


Safety on board! On sea, safety is a priority!

TASK

1

As part of this task, you will need to look out for all of the things that Red Funnel are doing which are related to the safety of the people who use the services that they provide (and the people who they employ).

Your investigation needs to start as soon as you enter the port.

- » You may notice that the staff are wearing certain clothes; you may see specific signs; you might notice how different passengers are treated in different ways.
- » Once on board, you are then going to search the ship for anything which shows that Red Funnel is looking after the health and safety of its customers.
- » Photograph any evidence and/or note down your observations on the table on page 2.
- » Remember – you will need to search above eye-level as things aren't always right in front of you.



CAUTION! It isn't just about the physical things that you see:

- ▶ How does the company inform people what to do in the case of an emergency?
- ▶ Listen out for the announcements and record the key information too.
